
Key topics covered:

Year 8 Intent: All pupils will complete a range of activities designed to allow them to **EXPLORE** the impact of positive self-image and good learning habits on their career choices.


Key topics covered:

Year 10 Intent: All pupils will complete a range of activities designed to allow them to **PLAN** their pathway to achieve future career goals whilst considering a range of options.


Key topics covered:
